


## Cervical Degenerative Disc Disease (DDD)

## What is it?

Cervical DDD is the arthritic changes of the discs between the cervical vertebral bodies. This often causes pain and stiffness. Sometimes, this is associated with compressed nerves. A damaged cervical facet can radiate pain to various areas in the head, neck, shoulder, and upper back.



## How is it treated?

- Manual therapy Physical therapy, Chiropractic, Osteopathic Manipulation
- Massage Therapy peanut ball massage
- Acupuncture
- Home neck traction device
- Aerobic exercise stationary bike, Aquafit
- Medicine Tylenol, NSAIDs (ie: Ibuprofen, Naprosyn, etc)
- Injections Cortisone Facet injections, Trigger Point injections, Prolotherapy injections
- Surgery often not recommended
